Cookie Booths at local businesses are the number one way our girls sell cookies, so the success of our Cookie Program depends on businesses like you. The Girl Scout Cookie Program helps Girl Scouts develop real-world skills in five essential areas:



1 Goal Setting
Girl Scouts learn how to set goals and create a plan to reach them. How you can help: Encourage them to set incremental, achievable goals. Work with them to break down their goals into small, frequent wins, like weekly challenges.

2 Decision Making
Girl Scouts learn to make decisions on their own and as a team. How you can help: Talk about how they plan to spend the troop's cookie earnings.

3 Money Management
Girl Scouts learn to create a budget and handle money. How you can help: Build on their interest in learning to manage all facets of the cookie business, like creating a budget to fund a troop experience or figuring out the percentage of customers who chose the donation option.

3 People Skills
Girl Scouts find their voices and build confidence through customer interactions. How you can help: Ask them about new marketing ideas they want to try. They can discuss how to tailor their cookie pitch to achieve their goals.

4 Business Ethics
Girl Scouts learn to act ethically, both in business and life. How you can help: Talk to them about the importance of delivering on their promise to customers. They can also consider offering a cookie donation option.

- Standard hours for Girl Scouts of Tropical Florida Cookie Booths are:
Weekdays: 3pm to 7pm or 4pm to 8pm
Weekends and Holidays: 8am to 8pm
You are welcome to allow additional hours or restrict hours and dates according to your preference. To do so, indicate your preferences on our Cookie Booth Business Registration Form.
- Please indicate the dates and times Girl Scouts may set up Cookie Booths at your location on the Cookie Booth Business Registration Form. Cookie Booth locations will be available on the Cookie Finder website and app, which allows customers to find their favorite cookies at local establishments.
- Not all Cookie Booth slots that a business makes available will necessarily be reserved by a Troop. Troops select slots that work best for their schedule. Troops reserve Cookie Booths through Girl Scouts of Tropical Florida Council, so if you would like a copy of the schedule please email customercare@girlscoutsfl.org.
- Girl Scouts understand that booth space is a privilege that stores have extended to them. If Girl Scouts cause an issue at any time please ask them to leave immediately, and contact the staff at Girl Scouts of Tropical Florida at 305-878-8467 or customercare@girlscoutsfl.org so we can provide additional training on appropriate behavior.
