

Cookie Booth and Beyond Ideas

Hosting cookie booths are a great way to sell your Girl Scout cookies and reach more customers. While participating in council sponsored booths such as Publix, Walmart, Milam's and Winn Dixie are great options, there **Lemonade stand booths:** These are private booths that you can decide on. Do you attend a church or temple where you can set up your booth? Maybe a family member's workplace or even your front yard can be good places for a sale. Lemonade stands can be wherever you think is a great selling spot, just make sure your parents approve.

- **Privately secured booths:** Is there a store, restaurant, or office that you think would be a great location for sales? As long as your parents approve, you can ask the owners of the business if they will allow you to set up your booth. If so, great! If not, keep thinking of other spots, many business owners love supporting Girl Scouts!
- **Walkabouts:** Load a cart or wagon with cookies and hit the road! You can walk around your neighborhood and ask neighbors if they would like to buy cookies. Neighbors usually are great repeat customers! There are also many parks or sports fields where you could walk around and find customers. Make sure to go with a caregiver!
- **Textathon:** Set up your digital cookie site then take some to text all family and friends to help you reach your goals. Halfway through the sale send another reminder.
- **Be creative:** There are many options for cookie booths and you can get creative with the location or booth style you'd like. If you are not sure if it's a good idea, you can ask your parents or contact council to make sure.
