For over 100 years, Girl Scouts in Miami and the Florida Keys have been dreaming big and doing good. From protecting our unique ecosystems to addressing food insecurity in their neighborhoods, Girl Scouts have always been at the forefront of community leadership.

Founded in 1923 by the first troop in Coconut Grove, **Girl Scouts of Tropical Florida** has grown into the leading organization for girl development in the region. Today, we serve nearly 3,000 girls across Miami-Dade and Monroe Counties, empowering them with the skills, confidence, and support to lead in their communities and beyond.

Florida Girls Are at a Crossroads

The Challenge:

According to the State of the Florida Girl Report*, today's girls face unprecedented pressures:

Emotional Wellness:



Nearly half of all girls in Florida report feeling so sad or hopeless for at least two weeks in a year that they stop participating in regular activities.

Mental Health Access:



Over 50% of Florida youth in need of mental health services are not receiving them—many of them girls.

Academic & Social Pressures:



Girls are navigating intense competition in school, family expectations, and the influence of social media.

STEM Gender Gap:



Women make up 47% of the workforce but only 28% of STEM jobs.

Troops offer a community where girls feel seen, heard, and valued.

Emotional Resilience:

Through our STEM Pledge, we're preparing 2.5 million girls nationwide to lead in fields like cybersecurity, robotics, and environmental science.

STEM

Girls explore hands-on activities in science, technology, engineering and math that spark curiosity and learning.

Outdoors and the Environment

Through camping, hiking, and environmental stewardship, girls develop resilience, leadership, and a deep appreciation for nature.

Life Skills

From financial literacy and civic engagement to healthy living and communication, girls gain practical skills to navigate life with confidence and purpose.

Entrepreneurship

Through the iconic Girl Scout Cookie Program, girls learn goal setting, decision making, money management, communication, and business ethics—skills that last a lifetime.

GIRL PROGRAMS




