Me, Myself, & I Campout

October 5

Fifty-seven Girl Scouts from eight Community Troops, along with sixty-eight volunteers and parents, participated in the Me, Myself & I Campout focused on self-confidence and well-being. Brownies explored fueling their bodies and movement for fun, Juniors celebrated what makes them unique, and Cadettes, Seniors, and Ambassadors focused on self-acceptance and self-care.



Shark Tagging

October 10-12

Eighteen Girl Scouts participated in a weekend Shark Tagging experience through the FINS (Females in Natural Sciences) program at the University of Miami Rosenstiel School. Supported by NOAA and the National Marine Sanctuaries Foundation, girls engaged in hands-on marine science activities, including shark tagging and learning from women scientists, while exploring careers in conservation.

November 1

Seventeen Community Troop Girl Scouts and their families participated in a Teddy Bear Tea event focused on building confidence and social skills. Girls practiced proper introductions, table manners, and etiquette while strengthening communication skills in a supportive, engaging setting.

Cookie Season

January 10 - February 22
