



Burger King Foundation Gold Award Scholarship

Burger King Foundation seeks to award a scholarship to a Gold Award Girl Scout who has made a significant positive impact on people and their community. This \$2,500 scholarship will be awarded to one qualified candidate.

Criteria for Selection:

1. Applicant must be active in Girl Scouts of Tropical Florida for at least 2 years and must exemplify the Girl Scouts mission of courage, confidence, and character.
2. Applicant must have earned/be in the process of earning a Gold Award and provide (1) a short 3-minute video describing the Project and (2) title and a written abstract, limited to 250 words.
3. Applicant must either be 1) in her junior or senior year of high school in Miami-Dade or Monroe and have a GPA of 3.0 or higher (on a 4.0 scale) or be 2) enrolled at an accredited post-secondary institution in the US with a declared health-related major and have a GPA of 3.0 or higher (on a 4.0 scale).
4. Applicant must answer the following prompt questions in at most 250 words each:
 - How has Girl Scouts prepared you for your future career?
 - How have you/can you further impact your community?

Deadline for Submission of the Application Packet is May 15, 2026. Top candidates will be called back for a virtual interview in early May. Scholarship awards will be announced during the Girl Scouts High Awards Ceremony on June 7.
